

ORDINANCE NUMBER 656

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 21st STREET BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST AND WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO GRADE, ALIGNMENT OR QUALITY, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH JEFFERSON STREET SOUTHERLY TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAKE ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That 21st Street from its intersection with Jefferson Street southerly to its intersection with Lake Road, be improved by construction of curbs and sidewalks, along both sides thereof, where none now exist or where such as do exist do not conform to City standards as to alignment, grade or quality, between the following termini:-

Beginning at the intersection of the southerly line of Jefferson Street; thence southerly along said 21st Street to its intersection with the northerly line of Lake Road.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to and by this reference made a part of this ordinance; and which plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution Number 14-1956 by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, on the 23rd day of July, 1956.

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this ordinance, the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement, by publishing notice thereof in the Daily Journal of Commerce at least one time.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of drainage conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the City Council and its signing by the Mayor.
