

ORDINANCE NUMBER 660

An ordinance declaring the assessment for the construction of a sanitary sewer along Adams St. from 42nd St. to the Easterly Boundary of Keil Heights, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Milwaukie does Ordain as follows:

Section 1. The assessment for the construction of a sanitary sewer along Adams Street from 42nd St. easterly to the easterly boundary of Keil Heights, Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, hereby is declared and levied as set forth in Assessment roll 70 now on file in office of the City Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. The whole cost of the improvement made by the construction of a sanitary sewer along Adams street from 42nd St. to the easterly boundary of Keil Heights is declared to be the sum of \$3,283.99

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of said improvement be declared and levied in order to secure funds with which to pay the cost thereof and maintain public credit; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval and signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 11th day of February, 1957.

Read the second time and unanimously passed by all of the members of the Council this 11th day of February, 1957.
