

ORDINANCE NUMBER 661

An ordinance declaring the Assessment for the improvement of 21st Street by the construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways along both sides thereof, where none existed and where they did exist but did not conform to city standards as to grade, alignment or quality, from its intersection with Jefferson street, southerly to its intersection with Lake Road, and declaring an emergency.

Milwaukie Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of 21st street, by the construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways along both sides thereof, where none existed and where they did exist but did not conform to city standards as to grade, alignment or quality, from its intersection with Jefferson Street, southerly to its intersection with Lake Road, is hereby declared and levied according to Assessment Roll Number 69, now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement of said street is hereby declared to be \$ 4,343.18 .

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said street be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and to maintain public credit; therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval and signing by the Mayor.

Read for the first time this 11th day of February, 1957

Read the second time and Unanimously passed by all of the members of the council this 11th day of February, 1957.
