

ORDINANCE NO. 668

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL CITY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ON THE 7th DAY OF MAY, 1957, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAID CITY TO INCLUDE IN THE BUDGET AND LEVY THE SUM OF \$7,277.30 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1957-1958 FOR GENERAL CITY PURPOSES, WHICH AMOUNT EXCEEDS THE CONSTITUTIONAL SIX PER CENT LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF OREGON, AND WHICH AMOUNT IS IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES LEVIED.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at a special election to be held at the time and place hereinafter prescribed.

Section 2. At the said special election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, be authorized and directed to include in the budget and levy the sum of \$7,277.30 for the fiscal year 1957-1958, for general city purposes, which sum exceeds the six per cent limitation on taxation as set forth in Section 11, Article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon, which shall be in addition to all other taxes levied."

Section 3. That the said special election shall be held on the 7th day of May, 1957, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M., Pacific Standard Time.

Section 4. That there shall be one polling place for said special election for all the territory located within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and for all the legal voters therein, to-wit: City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon.

The Judges of said special election will be Zenas Olson, Chairman, and Mauda Espejo, and they are hereby appointed to act as such officers.

The Clerks of said special election will be Hilda Burdick and Priscilla Adams, June Groh, and they are hereby appointed to act as such officers.

The said Judges and Clerks shall receive as full compensation for their services as such officers the sum of \$ 8.00 per day each.

Section 5. The Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said special election by posting a notice thereof in three public places within the boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for a period of at least ten days prior to the date of said special election, and by publishing a notice of said special election once in the Milwaukie Review, the official city newspaper, at

least ten days prior to said election. Said notice shall contain the time and place of the election, and the measure voted upon.

The Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby further ordered and empowered to make all other arrangements and to secure the necessary supplies for said special election.

Section 6. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently and immediately required that additional tax revenues be provided for to meet the increased cost of government and to maintain the public credit, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.
