

ORDINANCE NUMBER 673

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER ALONG A PORTION OF MAIN STREET, BETA STREET AND SHORT STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That sanitary sewers be constructed along Main Street from a point which is parallel with the northerly boundary line of the property now known as the International Harvester property, thence northerly to Beta Street; thence Easterly along Beta Street to Short Street; thence Northerly along Short Street to Stubb Street.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution Number 9-1957, by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 22nd day of ~~May~~ *April* 1957.

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said sewers.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage and drainage conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, and adjacent territory, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Council and its signing by the Mayor.
