

ORDINANCE NUMBER 674

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN EIGHT INCH WATER MAIN ALONG BETA STREET FROM McLOUGHLIN BOULEVARD TO SHORT STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an eight(^{inch}8") water main be laid along Beta Street a distance of approximately Seven hundred fifty (750) feet and between the following termini: Beginning at the twelve inch water main in McLoughlin Boulevard running easterly along Beta Street to the eight inch water main in Short Street.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby referred to, and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution Number 10-1957, by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 22nd day of ~~April~~, 1957

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting ^{into} ~~proposals~~ for the construction of said water main.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said water main is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for industrial development and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions at this time, an emergency is ~~therefor~~ hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Council and its signing by the Mayor.

Read the second time and passed by the Council this 20 day of May 1957
