

ORDINANCE NUMBER 675

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAIN STREET FROM STATE HIGHWAY STATION 337+00 TO STATE HIGHWAY STATION 347+20, BY CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Main Street be improved by the construction of curbs along both sides thereof, beginning at State Highway Station 337+00 and ending at State Highway Station 347+20

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance, and which said plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution Number 7-1957 by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 22nd day of April, 1957.

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and in order to take advantage of weather conditions, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall ~~go into~~ ^{be in} full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.
