

ORDINANCE NUMBER 682

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF A PORTION OF PENZANCE STREET, BY CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH MONROE STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Penzance Street be improved by the construction of Curbs, Sidewalks and Driveways along the southeasterly side thereof where none now exist, and along the northwesterly side thereof in front of Lot 8, Wilson Tract.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor, now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference, made a part of this Ordinance, and which said plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution Number 13-1957 by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 8th day of July, 1957

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting bids for the construction of said improvement.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and in order to take advantage of weather condition, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval and signing by the Mayor.
