

ORDINANCE NUMBER 683

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 28th STREET, BY CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST AND WHERE SUCH AS DO EXIST DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR CONSTRUCTION, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARRISON STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 28th Street be improved by the construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways along both sides thereof, where none now exist or where such as do exist do not conform to City standards as to grade, alignment or construction, from its intersection with Washington Street, northerly to its intersection with Harrison Street.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor, now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference, made a part of this Ordinance, and which plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution Number 14-1957 by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 12th day of August, 1957.

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting bids for the construction of said improvement.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and in order to take advantage of weather conditions, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval and signing by the Mayor.
