

ORDINANCE NO. 684

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF LOTS 8, 9, and 10, BLOCK 2, LEO ADDITION, IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 481 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 576 ACCORDINGLY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the written report of the City Planning Commission of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, embodying its recommendations that Ordinances No. 481 and No. 576 be amended so as to provide that the tract of land hereinafter described be removed from that area of said City zoned as Zone 3 R 1 by said Ordinance No. 481 and zoned as Industrial Zone, or Zone 2, by said Ordinance No. 576 amending said Ordinance No. 481, and that said tract of land be transferred to include within the area of the said City zoned as the Commercial Zone by said Ordinance No. 481, be and the same is hereby approved and adopted by the City Council.

SECTION 2. That Ordinances No. 481 and No. 576 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be, and they are hereby amended so as to remove from the area of said City therein described and zoned 3 R 1 and Industrial or Zone 2, the following tract of land, to-wit:

Lots 8, 9, and 10, Block 2, LEO ADDITION, in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 3. That said Ordinance No. 481 be and it hereby is further amended so as to include within the Commercial Zone established by said Ordinance the tract of land set forth and described in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That the City Manager be, and he hereby is directed to make appropriate changes on the Zoning Map of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, as will reflect thereon the zoning changes accomplished by this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof in this, that the result of the enactment of this Ordinance will be to accelerate city development, and preserve the public credit, therefore, an emergency is hereby adjudged and declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.
