

ORDINANCE NUMBER 687

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAGRAPH NUMBERED 12 OF SUBSECTION 3 OF SECTION 16 OF PART 3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 481, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph No. 12 of Subsection 3 of Section 16 of part 3 of Ordinance No. 481 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

12. Keeping of livestock shall be prohibited except in buildings that fully comply with building and sanitary codes. The keeping of chickens or other domestic or domesticated fowl shall be prohibited from and after January 1, 1958; provided, however, the Commission shall grant an applicant a permit to keep a family flock of chickens not to exceed 50 in number whenever such application is accompanied by the written consent of all of the owners of real property whose real property or a part thereof lies within 100 feet from any point on the boundary of the real property on which the chickens are proposed to be kept.

Section 2. In as much as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof in this, that it is urgently necessary for the protection of property owners in the quiet, peaceful and healthful enjoyment of their property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage and the signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 14th day of October, 1957.

Read the second time and passed by the unanimous vote of all of the members of the City Council this 14th day of October, 1957.
