

ORDINANCE NUMBER 689

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS ALONG RIO VISTA STREET, FRANKLIN STREET, RAILROAD AVENUE AND 46th STREET, ALSO FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A LIFT STATION AT RAILROAD AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The assessment for the construction of a sanitary sewer along Rio-Vista Street, from Railroad Avenue to the easterly boundary of Keil Heights; Franklin Street, from Railroad Avenue to the easterly boundary of Keil Heights; Railroad Avenue, from Adams Street to the easterly City limit line and 46th Street from Railroad Avenue to the south boundary of Martin Heights; and for the construction of a lift station at Railroad Avenue, in Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, hereby is declared and levied as set forth in Assessment Roll Number 73, now on file in the office of the City Recorder, Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. The whole cost of the improvement made by the construction of the above mentioned sewers and lift station is declared to be \$38,086.46

Section 3. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of said improvement be declared and levied in order to secure funds with which to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit, therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and signing by the Mayor.
