

ORDINANCE NUMBER 692

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PUBLIC STREETS HERETOFORE DEDICATED AS SUCH IN THAT PART OF MILWAUKIE INDUSTRIAL PARK, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, LYING TO THE EAST OF U. S. HIGHWAY 99E, THE PLAT OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN VOLUME 29, PAGES 12, RECORD OF TOWN PLATS, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, AS PLAT NO. 803, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The city Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, having heretofore by Resolution No. 17-1957 duly adopted at its regular meeting held on the 12th day of August, 1957, determined that the interests of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon required the vacation of the following intersecting public streets, to-wit: Milport Road from the east boundary line of Main Street easterly to the easterly boundary of Milwaukie Industrial Park, and Eastport Drive, from its southerly terminus northerly to the southerly boundary of Olson Avenue, being intersecting public streets heretofore dedicated as such in that part of Milwaukie Industrial Park, Milwaukie, Oregon, lying to the east of U. S. Highway 99E, the plat of which is recorded in Volume 29, page 12, Record of Town Plats, Clackamas County, Oregon, as Plat No. 803, and the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, having ascertained and determined that the market value of the property abutting upon the said public streets to be vacated will be increased by reason of said vacation, and the Council of the said City having heretofore by said Resolution initiated vacation proceedings looking towards the vacation of said intersecting public streets pursuant to the provisions of Section 271.130, Oregon Revised Statutes, and notice having been given as required by law that a public hearing would be held before the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 16th day of September, 1957, for the purpose of considering any and all written objections or remonstrances filed with the Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, prior to said date objecting to or remonstrating against the vacation of said intersecting public streets, and said public hearing having been held pursuant to said notice, and no written objections or remonstrances having been filed against said vacation with the Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and no person appearing at said hearing who objected or remonstrated against such vacations, the following intersecting public streets, namely, Milport Road from the East boundary line of Main Street easterly to the easterly boundary of Milwaukie Industrial Park, and Eastport Drive, from its southerly terminus northerly to the southerly boundary of Olson Avenue, being intersecting public streets heretofore dedicated as such in that part of Milwaukie Industrial Park, Milwaukie, Oregon, lying to the east of U.S. Highway 99E, the plat of which is recorded in Volume 29, page 12, Record of Town Plats, Clackamas County, Oregon, as Plat No. 803, are hereby vacated.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that the enactment of this Ordinance will be to accelerate industrial development within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and preserve the public credit, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 11th day of November, 1957, read the second time and unanimously passed by all the members of the City Council this 11th day of November, 1957.
