ORDINANCE NUMBER 693

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 28th STREET BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE EXISTED OR WHERE THEY DID EXIST BUT DID NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO GRADE, ALIGNMENT OR QUALITY FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARRISON STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an assessment for the improvement of 28th Street by the construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways along both sides thereof, where none existed and where they did exist but did not conform to City standards as to grade alignment or quality from its intersection with Washington Street to its intersection with Harrison Street, is hereby declared and levied according to ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBER 74, now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement of said Street is hereby declared to be One thousand eight hundred sixteen and 65/100 (\$1816.65) Dollars.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary for the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Street be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and to maintain public credit; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval and signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 9th day of December, 1957.

Read the second time and unanimously passed by all of the members of Council this 9th day of December, 1957.

Approved and signed by the Mayor this 9th day of December, 1957.
