

ORDINANCE NUMBER 707

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER TRUNK LINE ALONG LAKE ROAD AND A SANITARY SEWER ALONG 37th STREET NORTH OF LAKE ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That sanitary sewers, together with all things necessary in the construction thereof, shall be constructed in the following Streets.

A trunk line sanitary sewer along Lake Road a distance of 950 feet East of the present terminus of the sewer in Lake Road.

A sanitary sewer along 37th Street north of Lake Road a distance of 600 feet.

SECTION 2. That the construction of said sanitary sewers shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor, which have heretofore been filed with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to and by this reference, made a part of this ordinance, said plans and specifications having been adopted by Resolution Number 2-1958, of the City Council on the 17th day of February, 1958

Section 3. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance the City Manager shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said sanitary sewers, ~~by publishing notice thereof in the~~ _____

SECTION 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage and drainage conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Council and its signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 7th day of March 1958

Read the second time and unanimously passed by all of the members of the Council this 7th day of March 1958
