

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROCEDURE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, DISPENSING WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF SUCH ANNEXATION TO THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY, FIXING A DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON AT WHICH TIME THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY MAY APPEAR AND BE HEARD ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION, DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES AND IN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That procedure to annex the following described territory, which is continuous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of Section 25, Township 1 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian with the easterly right of way boundary of the Southern Pacific Main Line Railway as originally purchased; thence following the boundary common to Sections 24 and 25, said township and range, East to the east boundary of 36th Street, which is also the west boundary of the City of Portland; thence South on the east boundary of said 36th Street and the west boundary of the City of Portland and the southerly extension thereof to the north boundary of Lot 11, Block 1, FLOSS ACRES, a townplat recorded in Book 16, Page 21, RECORD OF TOWNPLATS for Clackamas County, Oregon; thence Southwesterly along the north boundary of said Block 1 and the extension thereof to the northeast corner of the William Meek Claim No. 50, T. 1 S., R. 1 E. W. M.; thence along the north boundary of the said William Meek Claim, West to its intersection with the east boundary of the Southern Pacific Main Line Railway right of way as originally purchased; thence following said railway right of way Northwestwardly to the place of beginning of the tract herein described.

Be and the same hereby is initiated and undertaken pursuant to the provisions of Sections 222.120, 222.130, 222.140, 222.150 and 222.170 of OREGON REVISED STATUTES.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon does hereby elect to dispense with, and does hereby dispense with submitting the question of the annexation of the territory described in Section 1 of this Ordinance to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3. That the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon hereby fixes the 9th day of June, 1958, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon as the time and place for a public hearing before the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at which time the registered voters of said City may appear and be heard on the question of such annexation.

Section 4. That a notice of the time and place of said hearing be published in the Milwaukie Review, a paper of general circulation in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, once each week for two successive weeks prior to the said date fixed for public hearing, and that The Chief of Police of Milwaukie, Oregon post in four (4) public places within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, written notice of said hearing and the time and place thereof for a like period of time.

Section 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage, drainage and sanitary conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie and adjacent territory, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the City Council and its signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 19th day of May, 1958.

Read the second time and unanimously passed by all of the members of the Council this 19th day of May, 1958.

Approved by the Mayor this 19th day of May, 1958.
