

ORDINANCE NUMBER 72E

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER ALONG HARRISON STREET EAST OF 42nd STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a sanitary sewer, together with all things necessary in the construction thereof, shall be constructed in Harrison Street, east of 42nd Street a distance of 500 feet .

SECTION 2. That the construction of said sanitary sewer shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications ~~attached~~ therefor, which have heretofore been filed with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to and by this reference, made a part of this ordinance, said plans and specifications having been adopted by Resolution Number 12-1958, of the City of Milwaukie by the City Council on the ninth day of June, 1958.

SECTION 3. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance the City Manager shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said sanitary sewer.

SECTION 3. Inas much as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage and drainage conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the Council and its signing by the Mayor.
