

ORDINANCE NUMBER 723

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORIES CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH ANNEXATION.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Milwaukie, Oregon, having heretofore by Ordinance Number 718, duly passed by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon on the 29th day of May, 1958, dispensed with submitting the question of the annexation of the territories therein described to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and having heretofore, by said Ordinance, fixed the 16th day of June, 1958 as the day for hearing at which the registered voters of said City might appear and be heard on the question of said annexation before it, and all required notices relating to such hearing having heretofore been published and posted as required by the provisions of Section 222.210, Oregon Revised Statutes, and public hearing having been had by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, pursuant to such notices, and no registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, appearing at said hearing who protested said annexation, and Herman G. Oetken and Edwina Oetken, husband and wife; James S. Lura and Arlene V. Lura, husband and wife; Alfred W. Gruhlke and Evelyn Gruhlke, husband and wife; Ezera H. Scheer and Violet Scheer, husband and wife; the sole owners of record of the territories to be hereby annexed, having heretofore, between the dates of May 9, 1958 and May 17, 1958, inclusive, given and filed their written consents to said annexation to and with the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, IT IS HEREBY DECLARED AND PROCLAIMED that the following described territories, situate in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:-

- (The West 250 feet of Lot 3, Block 4, HOLMWOOD PARK
- The west 230 feet of Lot 4, Block 4, HOLMWOOD PARK
- Lot 1, Block 3, PLIMPTON TRACTS
- Lot 4, Block 3, & the South 20 X 155.46 feet of Lot 5, Block 3, PLIMPTON TRACTS

which properties are contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

SECTION 2. The City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, a copy of this Ordinance, a copy of the written consent of the owners of all of the territories annexed and a copy of the Ordinance of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, being Ordinance Number 718, declaring that no election is required in said city, and to transmit further copies of said documents to the County Assessor, the County Clerk and the County Surveyor of the County of Clackamas, Oregon.

SECTION 3. The effective dates of the annexations hereinabove declared and proclaimed shall be the date upon which the documents referred to in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall have been filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Oregon.
