

ORDINANCE NUMBER 724

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER ALONG HARRISON STREET, EAST OF 42nd STREET A DISTANCE OF 500 FEET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The assessment for the construction of a sanitary sewer along Harrison Street east of 42nd Street a distance of 500 feet, is hereby declared and levied as set forth in ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBER SEVENTY-NINE, (79) now on file in the office of the City Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 2. The whole cost of the improvement made by the construction of a sanitary sewer along Harrison Street, east of 42nd Street, a distance of 500 feet, is declared to be the sum of \$1523.50

SECTION 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of said improvement, be declared and levied in order to secure funds with which to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit, therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and signing by the Mayor.
