

ORDINANCE NUMBER ~~726~~ 727

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS ALONG CERTAIN STREETS IN ARDENWALD AND 36th STREET AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRUNK LINE SEWER ALONG ROSWELL AVENUE, THE EASTERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, STUBB STREET AND SHORT STREET, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO GIVE NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS THEREFOR BY PUBLISHING OF SUCH NOTICE IN THE DAILY JOURNAL OF COMMERCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That sanitary sewers, together with all necessary things in the construction thereof, shall be constructed in

- 36th AVENUE, from Roswell Avenue to Sherrett Avenue.
- ROCKVORST ROAD, from Roswell Avenue to 28th Street.
- 28th AVENUE, from Roswell Avenue to Van Waters Avenue.
- 23th STREET, from Van Waters Avenue to Sherrett Avenue.
- 23th PLACE, from Roswell Avenue to Van Waters Avenue.
- 29th AVENUE, from Roswell Avenue to Sherrett Avenue.
- 30th AVENUE, from Roswell Avenue to Van Waters Avenue and from Sherrett Avenue southerly a distance of 150 feet.
- 31st AVENUE, from Roswell Avenue to Van Waters Avenue, and from Sherrett Avenue southerly a distance of 150 feet.
- 32nd AVENUE, from Roswell Avenue to Sherrett Avenue.
- VAN WATERS AVENUE, from 28th Street to 32nd Avenue
- SHERRETT AVENUE, from 28th Street to 32nd Avenue.

and that a trunk line sewer, together with all necessary things in the construction thereof, shall be constructed in

- SHORT STREET, from Beta Street to Stubb Street.
- STUBB STREET, from Short Street to the easterly right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company
- NORTHERLY along the easterly right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company to Roswell Avenue.
- ROSWELL AVENUE, from the easterly right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company to 36th Avenue.

SECTION 2. That the construction of said sanitary sewers and trunk line sewer shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefor which have heretofore been filed with the City Recorder; which plans and specifications hereby are referred to and by this reference, made a part of this ordinance, said plans and specifications were adopted by a Resolution of the City Council on the 11th day of August, 1958, as Resolution Number 14-1958.

SECTION 3. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said sanitary sewers and trunk line sewer by publishing notice thereof in the Daily Journal of Commerce at least one time.

SECTION 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage and drainage conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie and adjacent territory, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the City Council and its approval and signing by the Mayor.
