

ORDINANCE NUMBER ~~724~~ 728

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORIES CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH ANNEXATION.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Milwaukie, Oregon having heretofore, by Ordinance Number 726, duly passed by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the twelfth day of August, 1958, and approved and signed by the Mayor of said City on the 13th day of August, 1958, dispensed with submitting the question of the annexation of the territories therein described, to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and having heretofore, by said Ordinance, fixed the 29th day of August, 1958, as the day for hearing at which the registered voters of said City might appear and be heard on the question of said annexation before it, and all required notices relating to such hearing having heretofore been published and posted as required by the provisions of Section 222.120 Oregon Revised Statutes, and the public hearing having been had by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, pursuant to such notices and no registered voter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, appearing at said hearing who protested said annexation, and General Petroleum Corporation, H.J. Peckheiser, Vice President; E.B. McNaughton; George O. Smith and Wm.N. Smith; Harry W. Newman and Florence Newman, husband and wife; W.J. McCready Lumber Co, W.W. McCready, President; Silas F. Peake and Eva M. Peake, husband and wife; Pioneer Bank of Milwaukie, an Oregon Corporation, John M. Brown, Executive Vice President; Wm.B. Adams and Ruth Adams, husband and wife; Continental Assurance Company, Richard H. Samuels, Vice President; Milwaukie Lodge, A.F.&.A.M., Ralph C. Dimick, W.M.; Florence Ledding; Ruth Samuels; James A. Callahan and Marguerite B. Callahan, husband and wife; Ober K. Hall and Marcia L. Hall, husband and wife; Robert G. Canady and Dorothy Canady, husband and wife; Harold D. Carr and Elsie L. Carr, husband and wife; Leban W. Judd and Opal Judd, husband and wife; Elizabeth Darling Eick, Exec. Estate of E. Lillian Bogdon; the sole owners of the territories to be hereby annexed, having heretofore between the dates of DECEMBER 17, 1956 and AUGUST 7, 1958, inclusive, given and filed their written consents to said annexation to and with the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, IT IS HEREBY DECLARED AND PROCLAIMED that the following described territories, situate in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:-

Beginning at the most southerly corner of Block 1, LEWELLING PARK, a Townplat recorded in Book 7, Page 14, Record of Townplats for Clackamas County, Oregon and which ~~plat~~ ^{plat} is in the north boundary of Harrison Street; from said beginning point; thence following the north boundary of Harrison Street, North 81° 02' East 725.2 feet to the most easterly corner of Block 3, of said plat; thence following the northeasterly boundary of said Block 3, North 8° 58' West 235.45 feet; thence North 88° 45' East 44.24 feet; thence North 1° 15' east 200 feet to a point in the south boundary of the vacated portion of Llewellyn Street of the plat of Streib's Addition, a Townplat recorded in Book 8, Page 20, Record of Townplats for Clackamas County, Oregon; thence following the south boundary of said vacated street South 89° 38' West 78.7 feet more or less to the northwest corner of Block 1 of said Streib's Addition; thence following the west boundary of the last mentioned Block 1, South 8° 58' East 56.5 feet to the northeast corner of Block 3, said Lewelling Park; thence following the north boundary of said Block 3, South 80° 10' West 336.79 feet to a point in the northeasterly boundary of Lot 7, of said Block 3; thence North 8° 58' West 54.5 feet to the most northerly corner of Lot 8, of said Block 3 and the southwesterly extension thereof, South 81° 02' West to an intersection with the easterly boundary of the East Portland-Oregon City Highway; thence following the east boundary of said Highway and its southerly projection across Scott Street, Southerly and South-easterly to the place of beginning of the tract herein described.

The East 2 feet of Lot 22, Block 40, Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland. Lots 6, 7, 8 and Wily 5 feet of Lot 5, Block 40, Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland.

Lot 19, Block 8 BONNIE VIEW ACRES

Lots 1 and 2, ROCKWOOD ACRES *Can own part of lot.*

Lots 2,3,4, Block 8, BONNIE VIEW ACRES

Lot 1 and the North 15 feet of Lot 2, Block 8, BONNIE VIEW ACRES.

which properties are contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

SECTION 2. The City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, a copy of this Ordinance, a copy of the written consent of the owners of all of the territories annexed and a copy of the Ordinance of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, being Ordinance Number 726, declaring that no election is required in said City, and to transmit further copies of said documents to the County Assessor, the County Clerk and the County Surveyor of the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon.

SECTION 3. The effective date of the annexations hereinabove declared and proclaimed shall be the date upon which the documents referred to in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall have been filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Oregon.
