

ORDINANCE NUMBER 730

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 35th STREET, BY CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS, ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE EXISTED, OR WHERE THEY DID EXIST BUT DID NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO GRADE, ALIGNMENT OR QUALITY, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAKE ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That an assessment for the improvement of 35th Street, by construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways along both sides thereof, where none existed or where they did exist but did not conform to City standards as to grade, quality or alignment, from its intersection with Washington Street to its intersection with Lake Road, is hereby declared and levied according to ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBER EIGHTY (80), now on file with the City Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon

SECTION 2. That the entire cost of the improvement of said Street is hereby declared to be Twelve thousand four hundred twenty-eight and 46/100 dollars (\$12428.46)

SECTION 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Street be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and to maintain public credit; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval and signing by the Mayor.
