AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner or keeper of any dog or dogs in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large on the streets, alleys or highways in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, unless accompanied by the owner or keeper of such dog or dogs.

Section 2. Any person or persons who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon the conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of \$50.00

Section 3. This ordinance shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, at a special election to be called and held on November 4, 1958

Read the first time this 13th day of October, 1958

Read the second time and unanimously passed by all of the members of the Council this 13th day of October, 1958
