

SPECIAL MEETING OF JUNE 15, 1959

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the fifteenth day of June 1959, for the purpose of a hearing on the proposed annexation by election of territories in the Geo. Wills D.L.C., Derry Acres, Garner Tracts and Masonmead.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Clay.

Present: Mayor Clay; Councilmen Mortensen, Sedgwick and Howard; Manager Mullan, Attorney Sheldahl and Clerk Martin. Absent: None.

The Mayor opened the hearing on the annexation by election of territories in the Geo. Wills D.L.C., Derry Acres, Garner Acres and Masonmead, and called for objection to such annexation.

It was shown that proper notice of the hearing had been given by publication in the Milwaukie Review and by posters in the City. There was no citizen present who protested this annexation.

Ordinance Number 750 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Sedgwick and seconded by Mortensen that Ordinance Number 750 be passed to its second reading. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Clay announced that the Council would meet in special session on the morrow, June 16, for the purpose of reading Ordinance Number 750 for its second reading.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.

SPECIAL MEETING OF JUNE 16, 1959

Ordinance Number 750 AN ORDINANCE ordering an annexation election within the territory bounded as therein described, fixing the date of such election and the hours during which the polls will be open, designating the location of the polling place within said territory, designating the names of the Chairman and Clerks of said election, and directing publication of notice of said election, and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following results being had, Ayes: Clay, Mortensen, Sedgwick and Howard. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 750 was passed by the Council and so declared by the Mayor.
