



Ordinance Number 761, AN ORDINANCE, providing for the zoning of all property within 100 feet of Thirty-second Street on each side thereof, from Kelvin Street to Van Waters Street; providing for the rezoning of Lot 20, Block 1, Leo's First Addition, and providing for the rezoning of the north 200 feet of Tract "A" Cogwell's First Addition; Amending Ordinances No. 481 and No. 559; and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result: Ayes: Councilmen James M. Howard, Peter E. Mortnesen, E. H. Aebi, Theron E. Sedgwick and Earl M. Clay. Nays: None. Earl M. Clay, Mayor and Chairman, then declared that Ordinance Number 761 had passed the Council by the unanimous vote of all of the members of the Council.

It was then moved by Councilman James M. Howard and seconded by Councilman Theron E. Sedgwick that this adjourned regular meeting of the City Council be adjourned. Upon being put to a vote by the Mayor and Chairman, the motion carried unanimously.
