

ORDINANCE NUMBER 677

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAIN STREET FROM STATE HIGHWAY ENGINEER'S STATION 337+00 TO STATE HIGHWAY ENGINEER'S STATION 347+20 BY CURBS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the assessment for the improvement of Main Street, from State Highway Engineer's Station 337+00 to State Highway Engineer's Station 347+20, by curbs, is hereby declared and levied according to ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBER SEVENTY-TWO (72), now on file with the City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 2. That the entire cost of the improvement of said street is hereby declared to be \$2240.74. The total cost to be assessed to the improvement district is hereby declared to be \$1879.26.

SECTION 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said street, be declared ^{and} levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and to maintain public credit; therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing and approval by the Mayor.
