

ORDINANCE NUMBER 795

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING AN ANNEXATION ELECTION WITHIN THE TERRITORY BOUNDARIES THEREIN DESCRIBED, FIXING THE DATE OF SUCH ELECTION AND THE HOURS DURING WHICH POLLS WILL BE OPEN, DESIGNATING THE LOCATION OF THE POLLING PLACE WITHIN SAID TERRITORY, DESIGNATING THE NAMES OF THE CHAIRMAN AND CLERKS OF SAID ELECTION, DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore by Ordinance Number 792 declared the following territory located in Clackamas County, Oregon, and contiguous to the present boundaries of said City to-wit:

thence south to the east and west center line of Block 82, Minthorn;

Beginning at the intersection of the northwesterly boundary of the Otfield Road and the center line of Kellogg Creek in the south half of Sec. 36, T. 1 S., R 1 E., W.J., From said beginning point thence southeasterly and easterly, following the center of Kellogg Creek to its intersection with the south boundary of the Eliska Claim #54; thence following said last mentioned south boundary to the southeast corner of said claim in the east boundary of T 2 S., R 2 E., W.M.; thence South 100 feet more or less to the corner of Union High School #5 tract in Sec. 5, T 2 S., R 2 E., thence following the south boundary of the said school tract an extension thereof, east 1671.40 feet more or less to the east side of the Webster Road; thence following the east boundary of Webster Road north 700 feet more or less to its intersection with the south boundary of the Milwaukie-Estacada, Oregon State Highway; thence easterly following the southwesterly and southerly boundary of the State Highway and the easterly extension thereof to an intersection with the southwest boundary of the William Matlock Claim #37 in the said Sec. 5; thence northwest 650.0 feet more or less following the Matlock Claim boundary to the most westerly corner of said claim (northeast 1300.0 feet more or less following the northwest boundary of the Matlock Claim to its intersection with the west boundary of the State Highway); thence northerly 2500 feet more or less following the east side of the State Highway to its intersection with the north boundary of the Milwaukie-Foster Road (Harmony Road) near the northeast corner of Sec. 5; thence west and southwesterly 2400 feet more or less following the northerly boundary of the Harmony Road to its intersection with the west boundary of said Sec. 5; thence following the north boundary of said Sec. 5 and the westerly extension thereof to an intersection with the right of way boundary of the Southern Pacific Co.; thence following the last mentioned Southern Pacific Co. boundary northwesterly 4100 feet more or less to the most southerly corner of the present Milwaukie City as described by Ordinance #636; thence northwesterly following the westerly boundary of city annexation ordinances numbered 636, 637, 638, the south boundary of Adams Street in the plat of Minthorn; thence north to the northwest corner of Block 76, Minthorn Addition; thence in a general southerly direction following the easterly boundaries of annexation ordinances 637, 694, 773, 763 and 766, also a portion along the east boundary of the plat of Quincy Addition described in the Milwaukie Charter; thence general east boundary of annexation ordinances 680 and 704 to the east boundary of Lake Road; thence northwesterly following the south boundary of annexation ordinances 704 and 680 to the east boundary of Lot Whitcomb Claim and an angle point in the present city line; thence northwesterly and southwesterly following the present city line to the place of beginning.

to be annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, upon the condition that if a majority of the votes cast by the registered voters residing within said territory shall be in favor of annexation, it is hereby ordered that an annexation election be held within said territory submitting to the registered voters residing within said territory the question of whether or not such territory shall be annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon

SECTION 2. The date of said annexation election herein ordered is hereby fixed as the 3rd day of June 1960. The times during which the polls shall be open is hereby fixed as between the hours of eight (8:00) o'clock A.M. and six (6:00) o'clock P.M. on said day. The location of the polling place for the conduct of said election is hereby fixed as 3908 Lake Road, Milwaukie, Oregon, a place within said territory.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby authorized to cause to be published in the Clackamas County, Oregon, Official Gazette, a notice of said election, the date and hour of said election, the location of the polling place, the names of the chairman and clerks of said election, and the names of the candidates set forth in the ordinance. The cost of said publication shall be paid by the City of Milwaukie, Oregon. Doro Wand Flor Sign

SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby authorized to cause to be published in the Clackamas County, Oregon, Official Gazette, a notice of said election, the date and hour of said election, the location of the polling place, the names of the chairman and clerks of said election, and the names of the candidates set forth in the ordinance. The cost of said publication shall be paid by the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 5. In the event the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby authorized to cause to be published in the Clackamas County, Oregon, Official Gazette, a notice of said election, the date and hour of said election, the location of the polling place, the names of the chairman and clerks of said election, and the names of the candidates set forth in the ordinance. The cost of said publication shall be paid by the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby authorized to cause to be published in the Clackamas County, Oregon, Official Gazette, a notice of said election, the date and hour of said election, the location of the polling place, the names of the chairman and clerks of said election, and the names of the candidates set forth in the ordinance. The cost of said publication shall be paid by the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 2. The date of said annexation election herein ordered is hereby fixed as the 3rd day of June 1960. The times during which the polls shall be open is hereby fixed as between the hours of eight (8:00) o'clock A.M. and six (6:00) o'clock P.M. on said day. The location of the polling place for the conduct of said election is hereby fixed as 3908 Lake Road, Milwaukie, Oregon, a place within said territory.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby authorized to cause to be published in the Clackamas County, Oregon, Official Gazette, a notice of said election, the date and hour of said election, the location of the polling place, the names of the chairman and clerks of said election, and the names of the candidates set forth in the ordinance. SECTION 3. The following registered voters, residing within said territory, are hereby appointed and designated to act as Clerks of said election capacities set forth opposite their names:

- Signe C. Martinson, Clerk

SECTION 4. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to prepare notice of said election in the manner and form required by Section 222.130 Revised Statutes, and to cause the same to be published once each week for successive weeks prior to said election, in the Milwaukie Review, a paper of circulation in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon. The City Recorder is further authorized and directed to post a like notice of election in four public places within said territory for a like period of time.

SECTION 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and its inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage and drainage conditions which tend to impair the health and welfare of inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie and adjacent territory, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance will take effect from and after its passage by the Council and its signing by the Mayor.
