

ORDINANCE NO. 89.

Repealed by ordinance #1016

An ordinance dividing the Town of Milwaukie into wards and designating the division lines thereof.

The Town of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Town of Milwaukie be and the same is hereby divided into two wards with the following described line as a division line between said wards, to-wit; beginning at the intersection of the main line of the Southern Pacific Railroad track with the northern limits of the Town of Milwaukie, thence Southeasterly along said railroad track to Penzance Street; thence Southwesterly down Penzance Street to Fourth Street; thence Southeasterly down Fourth Street to Whitcomb Street; thence Southerly down Whitcomb Street to the boundary line between Holt and W. H. Grasles' property; thence southwesterly down said boundary line between Mr. Holt and W. H. Grasle to the Foster Road

Avenue. Thence Southerly along the said Foster Road to the property owned by Miss
y of May, thence Southerly along the easterly line of the Sinclair Prop-
f Milwaukie to Kellogg Lake.

That, that part of the Town of Milwaukie west of the said
line above described shall be known and designated as the First
the Town of Milwaukie, and that part east of said division line
known and designated as the Second Ward of the Town of Milwaukie.
