

ORDINANCE NUMBER 955

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MADISON STREET FROM 30th STREET WESTERLY TO HENNINGMAN'S ACRES, BY CURBS AND ASPHALTIC PAVEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION 1. That the assessment for the improvement of Madison Street from 30th Street Westerly to Henningman's Acres, by construction of curbs and that Madison Street be paved with asphaltic pavement from curb to curb from 30th Street to Henningman's Acres, is hereby declared and levied according to ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBER NINETY-FIVE (95), now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 2. That the entire cost of this improvement of said Street to be levied to the assessment district is hereby declared to be the sum of Four Thousand five hundred ninety-seven and 21/100 Dollars. (\$4597.21).

SECTION 3. In as much as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Street, be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and to maintain public credit; therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 14 day of January 1963.

Read the second time this 14 day of January 1963 and unanimously passed by all of the Council _____.
