Ordinance establishing the grades of De Witt Street in Milwaukee,  
Repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict  
with, and declaring an emergency.  
Town of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the grades of the center lines of De Witt  
Street be and are hereby established at the followings eleva-  
tions:  
At the South line of Washington Street. . . . .160.5  
250 feet south of the south line of Washington St..155.5  
Thence on a concave vertical curve with a middle or-  
dinate of 0.5 for 100 feet. . . . .155.4  
350 feet south of South line of Washington Street .155.5  
At the north line of 1st Avenue . . . . .159.0  
At the south line of 1st Avenue . . . . .160.0  
280 feet north of the north line of Second Avenue .187.0  
Thence on a convex vertical curve with a middle or-  
dinate of 0.85 for 100 feet at a point 180 feet north  
of the north line of Second Avenue. . . . .191.0  
North line of Second Avenue . . . . .192.0  
South line of Second Avenue . . . . .192.0  
280 feet South of the South line of Second Avenue .191.0  
Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith

hereby repealed.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate  
preservation of the public safety of the inhabitants of the Town of  
Milwaukee in this; it is necessary for the immediate preservation of  
public safety that De Witt Street be immediately improved and said  
street cannot be improved until the grades of said street are establish-  
ed. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall  
take into force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
