

ORDINANCE NUMBER 969

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROCEDURE TO ANNEX, WITHOUT ELECTION, CERTAIN TERRITORY, CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, FIXING A DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ON THE QUESTION OF SUCH ANNEXATION, DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The consent of LLOYD J. WAYMIRE and MYRTLE L. WAYMIRE, husband and wife; ARCHIE M. TIMMONS and JANE TIMMONS, husband and wife; TO THE ANNEXATION OF THE FOLLOWING TERRITORY:

LOT 2 and the West 80 feet of LOT 3; BLOCK 3, ELDORA ADDITION
LOT 1, BLOCK 4, FURNBERG PARK.

to the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, and of which they are the sole owners of record of the tracts comprising said territory set forth in their consent in writing, said territory being contiguous to the present boundary of the city of Milwaukie and situated in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby elect to dispense with submitting the question of the annexation of these territories to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

SECTION 3. That the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, hereby fixes the 9th day of April 1963, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, as the time and place for a public hearing before the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at which time and place the registered voters of the said City may appear and be heard upon the question of such annexation.

SECTION 4. That notice of such time and place of such hearing be published in the Milwaukie Review, a newspaper of general circulation in Milwaukie, Oregon, once each week for two successive weeks prior to the said date fixed for public hearing, and that the City Recorder cause public notice to be posted in four public places within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, said notice to show the time and place of said public hearing, and be posted a like period of time.

SECTION 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is immediately necessary for the preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that the result of the enactment of this ordinance will be to place valuable and extensive property upon the tax rolls, provide the City with new sources of revenues, accelerate sanitary development and preserve the public credit, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.
