November 1913. We find and determine that the Oregon and California Land Company and the Oregon and California Railroad Company, as owners of the above described tract of land which will be appropriated to the public use by the extension of Laurel Avenue, will be damaged and said land will be rendered less valuable by reason of said extension of Laurel Avenue, and we estimate and assess damages in the sum of \$1,000.00.

We find and determine that the Oregon and California Land Company and the Oregon and California Railroad Company, as owners of the tract of land abutting on the proposed extension of Laurel Avenue, will be specially benefitted and said land will be rendered more valuable by reason of the extension of Laurel Avenue, and we estimate and assess said benefits and advantages in the sum of \$560.00.

We find that the excess of damages over benefits that the Oregon and California Land Company and the Oregon and California Railroad Company, as owners of the above described property, will sustain by reason of the extension of Laurel Avenue will be the sum of \$440.00.

We find and determine that the persons named in the table next following, as the owners of the lots, parts thereof or tracts of land set opposite their names, respectively, no part of which will be required or taken for the extension of Laurel Avenue, will sustain no damage whatever, but said persons will be specially benefitted thereby, and we find and assess the value of the benefits that will accrue to said persons as the owners of lots, parts thereof or tracts of land aforesaid, to be the sums set opposite their respective names, which sums are also the excess benefits over damages, accruing to said persons by the extension of Laurel Avenue.
