DESCRIPTION: Built about 1926 by John Bertman and his wife Emilie, who farmed this area and raised their family; the house changed hands from Bertman to the City of Milwaukie.

STYLE: Colonial Revival - Prairie Style STORIES: 2½
DATE: 1926 CONDITION: Good ARCHITECT:
SIDING: Stucco
ROOF: Clipped gable w/partial return wide overhanging eaves
DOORS: Panel & single pane door w/corbeled sash bar
WINDOWS: Mostly 1/1 double, 2 that flank front door are fixed sash w/transom window
MAIN ENTRANCE: Front porch supported by thick plain posts on concrete bases w/decorative balustrade Above is balcony, also w/decorative balustrade and clipped gable canopy, flash glass surrounds fixed pane in frontal gable peak.
NOTES: Rectangular bay on north and south elevations w/shed roof, extension on rear was probably a porch and was enclosed
