WINDOWS: Fixed sash, lattice in upper sash of double hung, beveled & leaded glass, polygonal bayon south elev., string molding above lintel on first floor.
MAIN ENTRANCE: Hip roof porch supported by large posts on river rock bases, balustrade appears to have been removed, above front porch is horseshoe or Byzantine arch treatment outlining former sleep area(?)
NOTES: Siding in first floor soffit area - vertical tongue and groove
