## HISTORIC INTEREST:

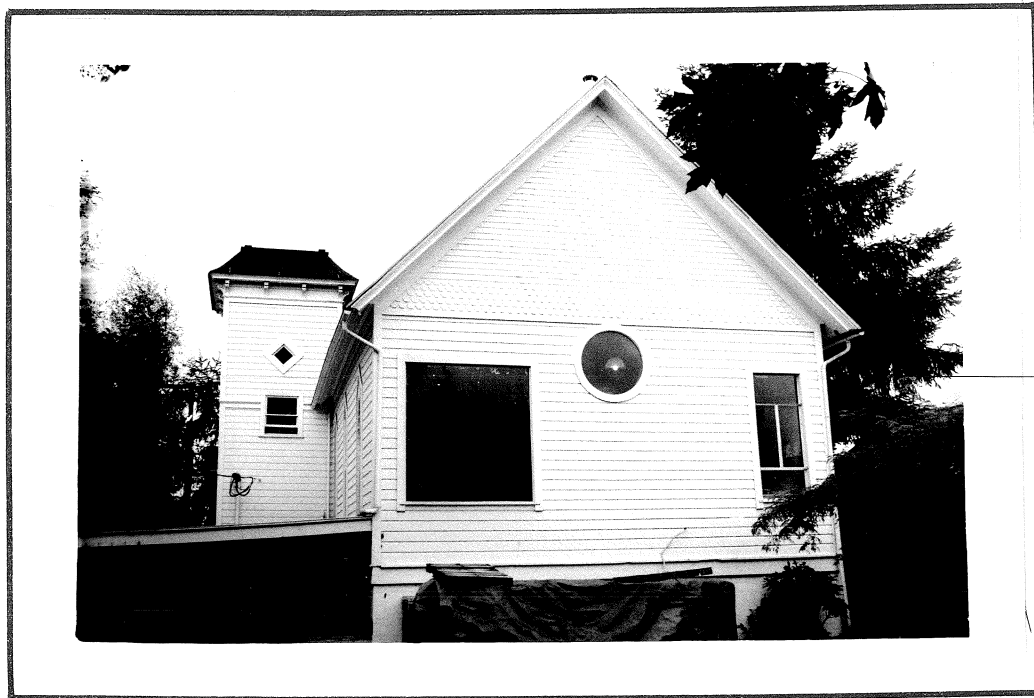
THEME: Culture - religion; architecture - 19th Century DATE: ca. 1895  
DESCRIPTION: Ardenwald Congregational Church built in 1886 at 32nd and Van Water. Rev. George Alpha Rockwood founded and constructed the church which at that time had a steeple. It was later sold to a group of Southern Baptists who sold it later on. Ca. 1974 - it became an art studio.
