

Beautifying the Landscape at Kellogg Creek Water Pollution Control Plant

The Kellogg Good Neighbor Committee, City of Milwaukie and Clackamas County Water Environment Services are working together on a landscaping project designed to beautify the environment and help control odor. To make way for the new plantings, approximately 60 trees, most of which are in poor health or dying, and many of the shrubs that line the McLoughlin Boulevard-facing fence will be removed.
