

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1913

BE IT RESOLVED by the common Council of the Town of Milwaukie that the following entitled Bills be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of the Town of Milwaukie at a special election to be held therein on the 18th day of March, 1913, for their adoption or rejection: "A Bill for an Act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to acquire, by arbitration or condemnation, Water Works and Water sources, or to construct, purchase, keep, conduct, operate and maintain water works in said Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, and to purchase and acquire Minthorne Springs, and own and possess real and personal property within and without the Town of Milwaukie for such purposes, and to issue and dispose of bonds therefor and establish rules, regulations and rates for the use and consumption of water by the said Town of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, who may be supplied by said water works;" Also "A Bill for an Act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter providing for and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to appropriate and condemn property within the Town of Milwaukie for the purpose of opening, laying out, establishing, widening, altering or extending streets, alleys, boulevards and lanes in the Town of Milwaukie, to appoint viewers to assess benefits and damages, and to provide for an appeal therefrom to the Circuit Court of Clackamas County, State of Oregon; and providing for the rights of way for sewers or drains, or for any such purposes, and authorizing the Council to do any and all things necessary to carry out such purposes; and providing for an appeal from viewers' report, the time and manner of taking and conducting such appeal, trial, judgment and costs on appeal"; Also "A Bill for an Act creating a Volunteer Fire Department and Fire Commission in the Town of Milwaukie, and amending subdivision One of Section 22 of Chapter 234 of the special Laws of the State of Oregon, enacted by the Twenty-third regular session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, filed in the office of the Secretary of State, February 11th 1905, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith, to-wit: "An act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, Oregon, passed by the Twenty-second regular session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and approved by the governor of the 4th day February, 1903, so as to provide that no levy of taxes on the taxable property within Milwaukie shall exceed one per centum per annum"; Also "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for the manner of exercising the initiative and referendum powers within the Town of Milwaukie"; Also "A Bill for an Act to amend section 3, 4, 6, 8 and 16 of the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, State of Oregon, so as to provide that elections shall be held biennially, and providing the qualification of electors of the said Town and the registration thereof, and providing the manner of nominating elective officers and providing for the division of the Town of Milwaukie into wards.
