

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1915

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE that the following entitled bill be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of the Town of Milwaukie at a special election to be held therein on the 21st day of August, 1915, for their adoption or rejection:

"A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas, in the State of Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for and authorizing said Town of Milwaukie to issue and dispose of \$25,000.00 additional water bonds for the purpose of completing the Bull Run Water System and installing water meters for each consumer."

ADOPTED THIS 21st DAY OF JULY, 1915.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1915

RESOLVED, that after hearing the evidence on both sides relating to the charges preferred by Mayor Pelton against Engineer Morris, we find no evidence to sustain such charges and find nothing to reflect on either the professional integrity or ability of Mr. Morris.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1916

Whereas, councilman J. B. Bond has moved away from the Town of Milwaukie and has ceased to be an inhabitant thereof, and has been absent from two successive council meetings,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that his office as councilman in Ward #1 in said Town of Milwaukie be and the same is hereby declared vacant.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1916

BE IT RESOLVED, that the users of water in Robertson be charged cost price for meters and connections to the Water System of Milwaukie, the same to be paid on or before the 1st day of March, 1917.
