

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1929

Resolution to join the League of Oregon Cities.

Whereas, the objects of the League of Oregon Cities are:

1. To maintain an organization to secure co-operation among the cities of the State in a thorough study of local problems and application of efficient methods of local government.
2. The collection and dissemination of information statistics, and data relative to all questions of local government.
3. The promotion of such legislation as will be beneficial to the cities of the State and citizens thereof, and the prevention of such legislation as may be injurious thereto.
4. To do any and all other things necessary or proper for the benefit of the cities of Oregon.

Whereas, the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, desires to have the advantage of membership in the League of Oregon Cities and give its full share of support to the objects of the same, now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that this City become a member of the League of Oregon Cities and that the City Recorder is hereby instructed to draw a warrant for \$10.00 in favor of the League of Oregon Cities for the annual membership dues.

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1929

Resolution and notice of the improvement of 35th Street northeasterly from Lake Road to the Northerly side of Blocks 20 and 21, Quincy Addition:

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his Report and filed in the Office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, Oregon, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of 35th Street, northeasterly from Lake Road to the northerly side of Blocks 20 and 21, Quincy Addition, in said Milwaukie, Oregon, according to the petition therefor and heretofore filed, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and Whereas, said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted, And,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie, Oregon, by its Council to make said improvement described as follows, to-wit:

1. By grading said street to the established grade.
2. By constructing a crushed gravel roadway 16 ft. in width and of suitable depth in the center of said street.
3. By constructing necessary catch basins and drains and cross-walks.

All work to be done in strict accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, and approved by this Resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, on or before 10 days from and after the 10th day of April, 1929.

The Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby directed to cause this Notice and Resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.
