RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1941

WHEREAS, the HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS, OREGON, is engaged in a housing project in the City of Milwaukie, known as Project ORE-1-3, pursuant to contracts between said Authority and the United States Housing Authority and Co-operation Agreements with the City of Milwaukie and the Housing Authority of the County of Clackamas, Oregon, and plans and specifications of which project have been submitted to the City Council of Milwaukie;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

(1) That the City of Milwaukie shall furnish the required water for Project ORE-1-3 on the basis of a master meter at the following rates:

- (a) 60 cents for the first 400 cubic feet for each occupied dwelling unit per month.
- (b) 12 cents for each 100 cubic feet thereafter, except the summer months of May, June, July, and August, when the rate shall be as follows:

60 cents for the first 400 cubic feet for each occupied dwelling unit per month;

12 cents for the next 100 cubic feet;

5 cents for each 100 cubic feet thereafter.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that if the City of Milwaukie increases or decreases its rates to other resident users, the rates named in (b) hereof shall be increased or decreased so as to be on the same basis as other Milwaukie individual resident users.
