

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1945

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be instructed and authorized to request the Secretary of State, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 122, Oregon Laws, 1945, to make an enumeration of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Recorder be authorized to pay the expense of said enumeration from the General Fund of said City.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1945

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that all portions of the City of Milwaukie, which are not now served by a sanitary sewer, will require the construction of such sanitary sewers within a short time

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Milwaukie; that Louis D. Kelsey, City Manager of the City of Milwaukie, be and he hereby is instructed to submit an application to the Federal Works Agency for advance planning funds to be used for the payment for Engineering Services and for plans and specifications in connection with the construction of the proposed sanitary sewers within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Milwaukie will endeavor to provide the necessary funds for said proposed sanitary sewers, through the assessment of property benefitted thereby to pay the cost and expenses of such sanitary sewers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That construction of such sanitary sewers be started within three years after the termination of the emergency.
