

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1950

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THERE NO LONGER EXISTS IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE SUCH A SHORTAGE OF RENTAL HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS AS TO REQUIRE RENT CONTROL IN SAID CITY OF MILWAUKIE.

WHEREAS THERE HAS HERETOFORE BEEN FILED with the Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, a petition requesting the termination of rent control in the City of Milwaukie, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie did in its regular meeting, held on the twenty-eighth day of November, 1949, set the 20th day of December, 1949, at 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day, in the Council Chambers in the City Hall of said City of Milwaukie as the time and place for a public hearing on said matter; and did direct that a notice of said hearing be published in the Milwaukie Review on the 8th day of December, 1949.

AND WHEREAS, at the time and place so appointed a meeting was held of the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, and that at that time no one appeared either for or against said proposal; and

WHEREAS, at said meeting it was, by vote of the Council, decided to continue said hearing to the 11th day of January, 1950, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., and

WHEREAS, at the meeting held on the 11th day of January, 1950, there appeared many persons in favor of said proposal and no one appeared against the same;

AND WHEREAS, it appears that there no longer exists such a shortage of rental housing accommodations as to require rent control in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that there no longer exists such a shortage of rental housing accommodations as to require rent control in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; and that the Housing Expediter be requested to terminate the provisions of the HOUSING AND RENT CONTROL ACT OF 1947, as amended, in so far as the same is applicable to the control of rents for housing accommodations in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; and that the Governor of the State of Oregon be requested to approve this resolution; and that a copy of this resolution as approved by the Governor of the State of Oregon be transited to the Housing Expediter.

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 2, 1950

WHEREAS, that portion of the Portland-Oregon City East Side Highway which extends from Scott Street northerly to the northerly limits of the City of Milwaukie; has never been officially named by the City of Milwaukie, and that that portion of the said highway which extends from Scott Street to the southerly limits of the City of Milwaukie was officially known as Front Street, and has been variously called Highway 99E, Portland-Oregon East Side Highway, Super Highway, and McLoughlin Boulevard, and

WHEREAS, the lack of uniformity in the designation of said street and highway has resulted in endless confusion,
