

RESOLUTION NO. 1, 1953

A RESOLUTION FORBIDDING PARKING AND LIMITING PARKING ON VARIOUS STREETS IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, AND REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP BEFORE ENTERING 21st STREET FROM JEFFERSON AND JACKSON STREETS.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to forbid parking on both sides of 32nd Street from its intersection with Harrison Street northerly to the City Limits.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to limit parking on 21st Street to two hours, from its intersection with Monroe Street southerly to its intersection with Washington Street.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to change the "NO PARKING" area on Monroe Street from the southerly side thereof to the northerly side thereof, from its intersection with 21st Street easterly to its intersection with 28th Street.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to require all vehicles to come to a complete stop before entering 21st Street at its intersection with Jefferson Street and at its intersection with Jackson Street.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

1. That all parking be forbidden on 32nd Street from its intersection with Harrison Street northerly to the City limits, on both sides of said 32nd Street.

2. That a parking limit of two hours be imposed on all vehicles parking on 21st Street from its intersection with Monroe Street southerly to its intersection with Washington Street, from the hour of 9:00 A.M. to the hour of 6:00 P.M. on all days except Sundays and holidays.

3. That the "No Parking" on the south side of Monroe Street from its intersection with 21st Street easterly to its intersection with 28th Street be and the same is hereby is repealed; and that parking be forbidden on the north side of said Monroe Street from its intersection with 21st Street easterly to its intersection with 28th Street.

4. That all vehicles be required to come to a complete stop before entering 21st Street from Jefferson Street and Jackson Street.

5. That this resolution go into effect immediately upon the posting of proper signs indicating the rules above established.
