

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1956

WHEREAS Chapter VII, Section 29, of the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, provides in part that all ordinances, immediately after being passed, shall be published once in the official city paper, and

WHEREAS the Milwaukie Review, a paper published and in general circulation in the City of Milwaukie for a good many years, has always been considered by the City Council as the official city paper, and

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable at this time to designate said paper as the official city paper by formal resolution

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the Milwaukie Review, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and the same is hereby designated as the official City Paper for the purpose of publishing ordinances as provided by Chapter VII, Section 29 of the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.
