

RESOLUTION NUMBER 10-1926

Whereas, heretofore there has been filed with the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, a certain petition signed by the resident owners of more than one-fourth the area of the real property, in a certain district, as hereinafter described, within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, praying for the making of certain improvements by the laying of sewers, and,

Whereas, the Council of the Town of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to grant said petition and make the improvement hereinafter described in the manner set forth, and has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement and an estimate of the total cost of the work to be done, and,

Whereas, the City Engineer has heretofore filed said plans and specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder, Now, Therefore,

Be It Resolved By The Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the aforesaid plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory, and are hereby approved, and,

Be It Resolved, that the Council does declare its intention of making said improvement, the location and kind of said improvement being as follows:

By the construction of certain sewers along the lines hereinafter stated, which said sewers shall include all catch basin inlets and all other things necessary in the construction of said sewers, all to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this resolution.

Said sewers are to be constructed along the following lines, and the termini and routes are as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Harrison Street and 29th Street, running thence on Harrison Street to the City Limits, with laterals to the north as follows: A lateral on 30th Street North of Harrison Street 695 ft. in length. A lateral on 31st Street north of Harrison Street 430 ft. in length. A lateral on 32nd Street North of Harrison Street 650.3 ft. in length. A lateral on 35th Street North of Harrison Street 470.5 ft. in length. A lateral on 37th Street North of Harrison Street 245.35 ft. in length. A lateral of Llewellyn St. East of 32nd Street 417.10 ft. in length. A lateral on Llewellyn St. East of 37th Street 1231.65 ft. in length.

The City Engineer's estimate of the probable total cost of said improvement is Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred Twenty and no/100 Dollars (\$15,620.00).

The district liable to be assessed for the aforesaid improvement is as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northerly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, where the projection of the northeasterly side of Block 2 Brownell Acres would intersect the same, running thence Easterly along the said northerly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie to the right of way of the main line of the Southern Pacific Railway; thence to the northeasterly corner of Gallop; thence along the northerly line of Block 3 Gallop to 31st Street; thence to the northwesterly corner of Block 2 Leo; thence to the northeasterly corner of said Block 2; thence easterly at right angles to the easterly property line of 32nd Street to a point which is 100 ft. distant easterly therefrom; thence southerly and parallel with the easterly property line of said 32nd Street and 100 feet distant therefrom to the northerly line of Block 2 Leo First Addition; thence along the northerly line of said Block 2 to the northeasterly corner thereof; thence to a point made by the intersection of the easterly property line of 34th Street and the southerly property line of King Street; thence easterly along the

southerly property line of King Street 100 feet; thence southerly and parallel with the easterly property line of 34th Street to a point where the same would intersect the westerly projection of the center line of Block 14 Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland; thence easterly along the westerly projection of the said center line of said Block 14, said Minthorn Addition, and along the said center line of said Block 14 Minthorn Addition to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1, Block 14 said Minthorn Addition; thence to the southwesterly corner of Lot 24 Block 13 said Minthorn Addition; thence along the center line of said Block 13 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1 Block 13 said Minthorn Addition; thence on a projection of said center line of said Block 13 to the easterly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie; thence southerly along the easterly city limits to a point where the same intersects the easterly projection of the center line of Block 41 in said Minthorn Addition; thence along said easterly projection and the center line of said Block 41 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 24 in said Block 41; thence westerly to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1 Block 42 said Minthorn Addition; thence along the center line of said Block 42 to the southwest corner of Lot 24 in said Block 42; thence westerly to a point in the westerly property line of 37th St. which is 100 ft. south of the southerly property line of Harrison St.; thence westerly and parallel with the southerly property line of Harrison Street and 100 ft. distant therefrom to a point in the southerly projection of the center line of Block 2 Brownell Acres; thence along the said southerly projection of the center line of said Block 2, and the center line of said Block 2 to the northeasterly side of said Block 2; thence along the northeasterly side of said Block 2 and the projection thereof to the northerly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie the place of beginning.

That the above described district is the district referred to in paragraph One (1) of this resolution.

Be it further resolved that the City Marshal shall within five (5) days from the date hereon give notice of the passage of this resolution by posting three (3) notices headed "Notice of Sewer Work" on the streets along the line of the contemplated sewer, which notice shall contain a copy of this resolution and shall set the time within which remonstrance against said improvement may be filed.

Be it further resolved, that objections and remonstrances may be filed with the Recorder against the aforesaid improvement at any time within ten (10) days after the date of posting of said notices by the City Marshal, and the same will be heard and considered by the Council at a special meeting of said Council to be held on the 25th day of August, 1926, at 8:00 o'clock P. M.

Whereas, it is necessary that the said improvement be made at as early a date as possible, as said sewer is urgently needed, and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions in the construction thereof: Now, Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution shall go into force and effect immediately upon its adoption approval.
