RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-1961

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and Fred E. Weber of Oswego, Oregon, have come to agreement as to the terms and conditions where the said City is willing to provide sanitary sewer service to the said Fred E. Weber who is currently engaged in the process of platting and subdividing a tract of land approximately three-fourths of a mile East of the East city limits of the City, hereafter referred to as "Baker Subdivision"; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of said Agreement have been reduced to writing in the form of duplicate counterparts; and
