

RESOLUTION NUMBER 9-1964

WHEREAS, by virtue of Ordinance Number 530 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the City Council is authorized to make changes in parking and traffic regulations by resolution to become effective when proper markers and signs have been installed; and

WHEREAS, traffic hazards have developed at the exit ramp leading from the east side of McLoughlin Boulevard to Main Street of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that all vehicles proceeding in an easterly direction along the exit ramp leading from McLoughlin Boulevard to Main Street of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be required to come to a complete stop before entering said Main Street, and that a proper sign be posted at an appropriate place to indicate the required stop.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE provisions of this Resolution shall be and become effective from and after the erection of the said stop sign as hereinabove stated.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 10-1964

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL CITY TAX BASE ELECTION IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ON MAY 15, 1964, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF ESTABLISHING A NEW TAX BASE FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, OREGON CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has determined that a new tax base should be established as authorized by subsection (2), Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in order to permit the proper operation of the city affairs within the limitation contained in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of establishing a new tax base to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the following proposition shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Resolution to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at a special city tax base election to be held on May 15, 1964;

"Shall the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, increase its tax base from \$68,178.81 to \$451,978.00?"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this special city tax base election be and the same hereby is called to be held concurrently with and as a part of the state-wide primary election being held in the State of Oregon and in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on May 15, 1964;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the regular polling places designated by the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon, in the voting precincts in the City of Milwaukie, hereby are designated as the polling places for the city tax base election; the poll books adopted by the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon, as the poll books for the state-wide primary election for the voting precincts in the City of Milwaukie hereby are adopted as the poll books for the city tax base election; and the judges and clerks of election appointed by the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon, to serve at the state-wide primary election hereby are designated as the judges and clerks of and for the city tax base election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the judges and clerks shall hold their respective offices as designated for the state-wide primary election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the polls for the city tax base election shall be opened in each of the voting precincts at the same hour, and shall be kept open until the same hour, as the polls are opened and closed for the state-wide primary election that will be held on the same day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of the city tax base election shall be given by posting notices thereof in three public places in each voting precinct within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at least ten days prior to the date of election, and by publishing notice thereof once in the MILWAUKIE REVIEW, the official city paper, at least ten days prior to the said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the notice published in the said newspaper and the notices to be posted in three public places in each voting precinct shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL CITY TAX BASE ELECTION

On May 15, 1964, in the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Pacific Daylight Time, a special city election will be held at which the following proposition will be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie for their approval or rejection:



This proposition, if adopted, will establish a new tax base for the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for the purpose of applying the limitation on taxation set forth in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution. The present tax base is \$68,178.81, the new tax base if adopted will be \$451,978.00, and the new tax base if adopted shall first apply to the levy for the fiscal year next following this election.

The city and county precincts within the City of Milwaukie will have uniform boundaries and the same election boards. The polling places in the City for the special city tax base election will be at the same places as provided by Clackamas County for the state-wide primary election to be held on the same day, May 15, 1964, and to such places as the election boards may legally adjourn.

The City Council by resolution has appointed the identical officers appointed by the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon, for the state-wide primary election as the judges and clerks of the special city tax base election to serve in each of the polling places in the respective precincts to which they are appointed by the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-1964

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NEGOTIABLE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, IN THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF \$150,000.00; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF SAID BONDS AND OF THE INTEREST COUPONS PERTAINING THERETO: PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF SAID BONDS AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SUCH SALE

WHEREAS, heretofore, on the 24th day of April, 1964, at a special election duly called and held in the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, the legal voters of said City duly adopted Chapter VIII-F as an amendment to the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, adopted by the people of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 7th day of November, 1944, as amended, which provides as follows:

CHAPTER VIII-F

In addition to the other methods provided by the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, or the General Laws of the State of Oregon, and not in derogation of any such powers, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, when in its discretion it is deemed advisable, may provide by resolution or resolutions for the construction, either by contract
