

southerly property line of King Street 100 feet; thence southerly and parallel with the easterly property line of 34th Street to a point where the same would intersect the westerly projection of the center line of Block 14 Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland; thence easterly along the westerly projection of the said center line of said Block 14, said Minthorn Addition, and along the said center line of said Block 14 Minthorn Addition to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1, Block 14 said Minthorn Addition; thence to the southwesterly corner of Lot 24 Block 13 said Minthorn Addition; thence along the center line of said Block 13 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1 Block 13 said Minthorn Addition; thence on a projection of said center line of said Block 13 to the easterly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie; thence southerly along the easterly city limits to a point where the same intersects the easterly projection of the center line of Block 41 in said Minthorn Addition; thence along said easterly projection and the center line of said Block 41 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 24 in said Block 41; thence westerly to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1 Block 42 said Minthorn Addition; thence along the center line of said Block 42 to the southwest corner of Lot 24 in said Block 42; thence westerly to a point in the westerly property line of 37th St. which is 100 ft. south of the southerly property line of Harrison St.; thence westerly and parallel with the southerly property line of Harrison Street and 100 ft. distant therefrom to a point in the southerly projection of the center line of Block 2 Brownell Acres; thence along the said southerly projection of the center line of said Block 2, and the center line of said Block 2 to the northeasterly side of said Block 2; thence along the northeasterly side of said Block 2 and the projection thereof to the northerly city limits of the Town of Milwaukie the place of beginning.

That the above described district is the district referred to in paragraph One (1) of this resolution.

Be it further resolved that the City Marshal shall within five (5) days from the date hereon give notice of the passage of this resolution by posting three (3) notices headed "Notice of Sewer Work" on the streets along the line of the contemplated sewer, which notice shall contain a copy of this resolution and shall set the time within which remonstrance against said improvement may be filed.

Be it further resolved, that objections and remonstrances may be filed with the Recorder against the aforesaid improvement at any time within ten (10) days after the date of posting of said notices by the City Marshal, and the same will be heard and considered by the Council at a special meeting of said Council to be held on the 25th day of August, 1926, at 8:00 o'clock P. M.

Whereas, it is necessary that the said improvement be made at as early a date as possible, as said sewer is urgently needed, and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions in the construction thereof: Now, Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution shall go into force and effect immediately upon its adoption approval.
