

2. That portion of 42nd Street as the same extends from S.S. Fields Road, sometimes known as Railroad Avenue, to the north line of King Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

3. That portion of Rio Vista Avenue, as the same extends from S.S. Fields Road, sometimes known as Railroad Avenue, to the East boundary of Keil Heights, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

4. That portion of Franklin Avenue, as the same extends from S.S. Fields Road, sometimes known as Railroad Avenue, to the East boundary of Keil Heights, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

5. That portion of Jefferson Street, as the same extends from 42nd Street, to the East boundary of Keil Heights, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

6. That portion of Llewellyn Street, as the same extends from 42nd Street to the East side of 44th Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

7. That portion of King Street, as the same extends from the East side of 40th Street to the East side of 44th Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

8. That portion of 40th Street, as the same extends from the North line of Howe Street to the South side of King Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

9. That portion of 40th Street, as the same extends from S.S. Fields Road, sometimes known as Railroad Avenue, to Adams Street, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

10. That portion of 46th Street, sometimes known as Walsh Road, from S.S. Fields Road, sometimes known as Railroad Avenue, to its northerly terminus, within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon be and he hereby is authorized and directed to request of the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon the surrender of jurisdiction over the portions of the County Roads as hereinabove described on behalf of the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-1956

WHEREAS, the following public streets to-wit: "B" Street, "C" Street, "D" Street, "E" Street and "F" Street being all of the public streets heretofore dedicated as such in that part of Milwaukie Industrial Park, Milwaukie, Oregon, formerly known as Kellogg Park, Milwaukie, Oregon, lying to the west of U.S. Highway 99E. the plat of which is recorded in Book 26, page 13, Record of Townplats, Clackamas County, Oregon, except McBrod Road and Milport Road in said part of Milwaukie Industrial Park as the said McBrod Road and Milport Road are described

in Ordinance 616 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, as the said Ordinance is recorded in Book 499 at Page 15, Deed Records of Clackamas County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the said public streets are streets which intersect and which are adjacent and parallel to each other, and

WHEREAS, all of said public streets lie entirely within the land now owned by the Public Housing Authority of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, after due consideration of the interests of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and its inhabitants, and after due consideration of the interests of the said Public Housing Authority and the public generally, deems it advisable to initiate proceedings to vacate the said public streets hereinabove described pursuant to the provisions of Section 271.130, Oregon Revised Statutes, and

WHEREAS, it is particularly desirable from the standpoint of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and its inhabitants that the said public streets be vacated in order that the Public Housing Authority of the United States of America may cause the property abutting on said public streets to be sold to business and industrial concerns whose ownership of said property will increase the tax revenue of the said City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has ascertained and has determined that the market value of the property abutting upon the said public streets to be vacated will be increased rather than decreased by reason of said vacation, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has been advised that the Public Housing Authority of the United States of America, which is the owner of all the property abutting upon the said public streets to be vacated will consent in writing to such vacation.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and she is hereby ordered and directed to cause notices of these proceedings and the public hearing to be had thereon to be published and posted as required by the provisions of Sections 271.130 and 271.110 of the Oregon Revised Statutes, and

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the 27th day of August, 1956, be and the same hereby is fixed as the date upon which said public hearing shall be held, and the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. be and the same is hereby fixed as the time at which the said public hearing shall be held upon said date, and the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, be and the same hereby fixed as the place at which said public hearing shall be held at said time and on said date.
