

Beginning at the intersection point of the east line of Main Street and the north line of the property presently owned by the International Harvester Company, in Milwaukie, Industrial Park, Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon; thence northerly along the east line of Main Street extended to the intersection of the south line of Stubb Street; thence Easterly along the south line of Stubb Street extended to a point which is 20 feet west of the west boundary line of the Southern Pacific Company's Tillamook Branch right-of-way; thence Southerly, 20 feet west and parallel with the said Tillamook Branch right-of-way to a point which is the north line of the said International Harvester property extended easterly to the said Tillamook Branch right-of-way; thence Westerly along the north line of said International Harvester property to the point of beginning.

That the Engineer's estimate of the cost per each square foot of land within the said proposed assessment district is \$ _____

That an assessment will be levied on all lots and parcels of land within said proposed assessment district, where said water main will be laid, in proportion to the amount to which each lot or parcel of land is benefitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of Police of Milwaukie shall, within ten (10) days from the adoption of this Resolution, give notice of the adoption of this Resolution by posting a notice headed with the title "NOTICE OF WATER MAIN EXTENSION WORK" in three conspicuous places along Beta Street, which said notice shall contain a copy of this Resolution, and shall specify the time within which a remonstrance against said proposed water main extension may be filed with the City Recorder, and that the Council will hear such remonstrances as may be filed, on the 13th day of May, 1957.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that said water main be laid as soon as possible, so as to take advantage of weather conditions, NOW THEREFORE AN EMERGENCY IS DECLARED TO EXIST, and this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately after its adoption by the Council.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-1957

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS PLACED IN AND GIVEN TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, BY ORDER OF THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS, COURT ORDER NUMBER 5123

WHEREAS, by appropriate statutory procedure, the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Clackamas did, by its Court Order Number 5123, place in and give to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, jurisdiction over the following County Roads and portions thereof, to-wit:

A PORTION OF THE N. J. ALLEN ROAD NUMBER 1022, OCHOCO STREET, EAST OF RIVER ROAD AND WEST OF MOORE'S STREET, COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 1979-J, LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS

COUNTY, OREGON.

AND WHEREAS the said County did, by its said order, further provide that the City of Milwaukie must accept said jurisdiction within ninety days from the date of the Order,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, and by virtue of the provisions of ORS. 373.270, that the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby accept the jurisdiction over the County Road hereinabove described, as the said jurisdiction was placed in and given to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, by Court Order Number 5123 of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Clackamas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copy of this Resolution be forthwith transmitted to the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Clackamas.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 12-1957

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO CONSTRUCT CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES OF 29th STREET, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST OR WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARRISON STREET, NORTHERLY TO THE CITY LIMIT LINE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to construct curbs and sidewalks along both sides of 29th Street from its intersection with Harrison Street northerly to the City limit line where none now exist or where such as do exist do not conform to City standards as to alignment, grade or quality, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for the appropriate improvement to accomplish the above, and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done, and
